In emergency situations, go straight to the emergency department. If you are experiencing non-emergent matters you should go to an Urgent Care facility or use your Telemedicine benefit and you will have less financial responsibility by paying a lower copay and/or deductible, depending on the plan you are enrolled in.



## **Urgent Care**

Severe Cold, Sprained Ankle, Viral Infection, Cuts and Scrapes, Ear Infections, Rashes.



## **Emergency** Room

Chest Pains,
Heart Attack,
Stroke,
Broken Bones,
Head Injuries,
3rd Degree Burns.



## **Telemedecine**

Allergies and Asthma, Cold and Flu, Urinary Tract Infections, Prescribe Medications and much more!
